Chinese Language Courses

Open to both university and community members

The UO Confucius Institute offers three levels (beginner, intermediate and advanced) of self-study courses through the Yamada Language Center (YLC). This course has no exams, though participants who take the course for credit will give a presentation in the final week.

The Self Study Language Program (LT 199) is based on connecting small groups of motivated students with tutors whose native language is the language of study. The YLC provides space, learning resources, curricular support, and the means to track and evaluate your progress.

Our classes are small (usually fewer than 5), have an emphasis on spoken language, and utilize a wide variety of materials to make this experience rich, both culturally and linguistically. You can take them for UO credit (1-3), or non-credit, as a community member (\$150).

Class time: Begins one week after spring term starts; ends one week before UO finals week. **How to register:** Visit Yamada Language Center website or come to McKenzie Hall at the University of Oregon.
